a. No Till Drill – This was originally purchased through a grant with the Genesee River Coalition of Conservation Districts. We are the only county using this no till drill, and at the last meeting they talked about giving us the drill and we would manage it ourselves. This will be decided at the next Genesee River Coalition Board Meeting.
