  - iii. Finalizing designs for repairing Genesee River erosion adjacent to Council House Road in Caneadea. We are working with DEC to secure EPA funding in the amount of \$568,300. If funded this will be 100% funded.

  - Michele Platt Project is to stabilize a 75' section of streambank that is eroding towards her driveway. Working on permitting.

- ii. Dale Skinner A 500' section of Angelica Creek is eroding toward their house. Need to do a site visit yet.
- iii. Dean Hint experiencing stream erosion along a 250' section of field. Working on an estimate and solution to the problem.

- q. County Road 7B have submitted permit application to the Army Corp of Engineers for the County DPW. This will be to stabilize a section of Caneadea Creek near a County bridge.
